Rules	The competition rules published under V9.0 on the official site http://www.gps-triangle.net/GPS-Triangle/Rules will be applied. Participants need to install SkyNavFlyer Software Version 1.5.4.2 or higher on their pocket PCs. A software upgrade service will be available on site before the contest starts.

Insurance	All pilots need to be insured for their models and can prove this at registration.
Frequencies	Radio controls: from 35,000 to 35,200 MHz, from 40,665 to 40,985 MHz and 2.4 GHz. The GPS frequencies will be assigned during the briefing. No other vario systems (except 2,4 GHz systems) are permitted during the contest.
